

Dietetic Intern Bursary Application Guidelines

Award:

Up to three bursaries of \$1,000 each will be awarded per year to students studying dietetics at the University of Alberta with the intention of becoming a Registered Dietitian. The students have demonstrated exceptional professionalism in professional practice.

- ⇒ Professionalism is defined as "the manifestation of optimal attitudes and behaviours in the provision of high quality services that place the interest of others above one's own self interest" (Kinsinger, 2005).
- An intern must display the basic tenets of professionalism in dietetics practice: professional competence (knowledge, skills, attitudes and judgments), professional conduct and professional image.

The College reserves the right to determine the number of bursaries awarded each year.

Individuals may apply themselves or be nominated by a preceptor or group of preceptors for the bursary up to three times and be awarded the \$1,000 bursary once. University of Alberta employees are not allowed to nominate a dietetic intern for the bursary.

Successful recipients will be chosen based on the eligibility criteria, essays and the demonstration of exceptional professional practice in internship.
